

## Green Means Go

The new Main Street was opened to the public on May 31, 2007. After the Route 94 traffic signal was approved for operation by the NJDOT, the Township received the 'green light' to open the roadway.

(Residents are reminded that parking on Route 94 in front of the Dunkin Donuts is prohibited pursuant to an ordinance passed by the Township Council. Signage will be posted shortly by the NJDOT. This is a health, safety and traffic concern.)

Main Street will serve as a critical bypass during

the reconstruction of Route 515. This work is being done by Sussex County, and the project is currently out to bid. Construction is anticipated to begin in August, and will continue for one year. The project limits are from the Route 94 intersection to several hundred feet south of the A&P.

Development on the new Main Street cannot occur until the expansion of the sewer treatment facility in Hardyston is completed by the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority. This expansion is currently scheduled for completion in 2009.

## Tax Deadlines

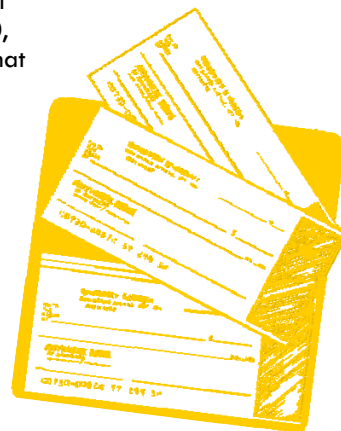
